



## Mt. Popa Full Day Sightseeing

**Tour Sites** : Mt. Popa full day Sightseeing

### Detail Itinerary

Start your sightseeing tour at 8:00 Am from your hotel. Rising 1,518 meters from the plains of the surroundings of Bagan, **Mt. Popa** is considered the sacred home of the spirits and is about a 1.5 hour drive from Bagan. Visit a palm village along the way; you can learn how to do palm sugar is produced. Continue to **Mt. Popa** and visit **Taung Kalat**, the temple which sits atop like a plug in the volcano and holds significance in Myanmar's history and religion. The monastery is home to the **37 nats (spirits)** of Myanmar, which are displayed at the base of the temple. **Mt. Popa** is also known as the Oasis of Central Myanmar. After visiting and leisurely, drive back to Bagan. As the sun goes down we will be at one of the ideal viewing sites selected by our tour guide for a panoramic sunset view over the temples. Transfer back to your hotel.
